INSPECTION CONSENT (Reproduce locally)

INSPECTIONS AND SEARCHES

At different moments during the training or activity, the cadet may be subjected to an inspection of his/her sleeping accommodations, luggage, kit, equipment, locker(s) or storage area(s). These will be conducted or supervised by a Canadian Armed Forces member, and will serve to verify that:

- the cadet's sleeping accommodations, locker(s) and storage area(s) are clean and orderly;
- the cadet is carrying the proper equipment and it is in good condition and properly maintained;
- the cadet's health and safety is not at risk; and
- the cadet does not have prohibited, restricted or unauthorized items in his/her possession, as listed in the joining instructions or other information document provided under separate correspondence.

If found, prohibited and restricted items will be handed to the applicable police agency (military or civilian) with some exceptions, while unauthorized items shall either be confiscated for the duration of the training or activity or sent back to the cadet's home at the parents expense, whichever is more practical and economical with some exceptions.

Corrective measures could be taken against a cadet for failing any criteria or search or for refusing to submit to an inspection, in accordance with CATO 15-22 Conduct and Discipline – Cadets, up to and including being expelled from the training or activity.

If needed, searches of a cadet's person, property, lockers, luggage, kit or sleeping area for the purposes of discovering contraband, illicit or stolen property, or some evidence of guilt to be used in the prosecution of an offence, will be conducted only by the Military Police or a civilian police agency.

From Friday 30 September to Sunday 2 October 2016, the 1913 Ontario Regiment Cadet Corps will participate in field training at Blackdown Cadet Summer Training Centre. All ranks will sleep in unheated tents both nights. Parents should note that this exercise will be conducted in seasonal weather conditions. Barring very unusual circumstances, Cadets will be expected to remain outside and participate in training activities ALL day and evening Saturday, and Sunday until departure time. With this in mind, participants in this exercise all cadets including new recruits are invited to participate. A prepared a list of equipment that is **REQUIRED** for all participants in this exercise is listed below. **Ensure you eat before arriving dinner will not be provided.**

As with all of our cadet activities, this exercise will be conducted by experienced and certified Canadian Forces instructors with special training for the safe conduct of field exercises. The safety of all participants is our top priority.

Cadets will report to Col R.S. McLaughlin, 53 Simcoe Street North at **1800 hrs**. Buses depart **PROMPTLY** at 1830 hrs. We will be returning to Col R.S. McLaughlin Armoury, 53 Simcoe Street North at approximately 1500. **Parents, please be at the Armoury to pick up your cadet, as the officers can't leave until all cadets have been picked up. Any cadet not picked up 30 minutes after the advised pick up time will be dropped off at the local police station.**

Dress for the exercise is FTU (field training uniform). Cadets who do not possess a FTU uniform will wear suitable civilian clothing. **Cadets arriving with kit deficiencies or without their health card will be sent home.**

NOTE: Cadets are required to bring the following kit. Cadets not in possession of a field training uniform need to bring civilian equivalent attire for these items.

Cadets will address any kit deficiencies with unit QM Stores prior to the Exercise weekend. The Cadet Corps is not responsible for any lost personal items; all personal items must be clearly marked.. Equipment not worn will be carried in either one clearly marked kit bag **OR** one rucksack which they are capable of carrying. No knives of any kind are allowed (other than multi-tool). **NO CELL PHONES, CAMERA'S OR FOOD ALLOWED (this includes staff cadets).** MP3's and I Pod's are allowed but are to be used during down time only. **Cadets are not to have these items on their person during training hours. Any Cadet found in possession of unauthorized items will face disciplinary action.** A hygiene search will be performed on arrival at the Armoury.
